VILLAGE PROJECT

Cllr J. Polglass produced a summary of the recent parish survey. Nearly 20% of the village households replied, which gave a good representative of views, which have now been collated. A number of parishioners did state, they would be happy to volunteer with certain projects if required.

The results were broadly divided into three themes, - Safety, Our Community - Village Appearance & Broadband & Mobile. Highlights as follows:

- Defibrillator – Cllr A. Jenkins to contact Tony Millward for more information  
Cllr C. Roome to contact British Heart Foundation re a possible grant, & speak with the Social Committee about some financial assistance.
- Neighborhood Watch – Clerk to contact P.C. J. Bointon
- Increase in movement of large vehicles – A meeting with a Highway Representative has taken place, resulting in a request for extra signage to be installed.
- Village Green mowing – As this is done by volunteers – Agreed - The need for them to be recognized & thanked.
- Flowers/planters – Cllr A. Jenkins to request donations.
- Poorly maintained footpaths – Cllr A. Jenkins to contact footpath maintenance.
- Digital Derbyshire – Broadband is in the process of being installed by December.

After a short discussion, it was agreed for Cllr J. Polglass to compile feedback, & gather & share information with the Social Committee.

Cllr A. Jenkins stated he is allocated £1000 per annum, towards local village projects.
